The following steps should be completed on your **iPhone**.




On your iPhone, open the **App Store.** Find this by swiping all the way to the right. Then find the app under the Utilities section.

In the App Store, search for **Microsoft Authenticator**. You might see it in the suggestions as you type.









Select Get or . This option may vary depending on if you've downloaded the Microsoft Authenticator before.

Once downloaded, tap Open .


Or, find the app by swiping your Home Screen all the way to the right and searching at the top.






Tap Accept, then Continue.

Tap **Skip.**






The following steps should be completed on your **Computer.** Your GadellNet engineer will assist in navigating to **Office.com.**








Step 9

Point your iPhone's camera at your computer's display by **positioning the QR code inside the box.**
